
Peter Worth Walks

About Peter Worth c491

Peter Worth qualified as a Centurion in 1972 just ten days before his forty-third birthday and went on to complete seven British 100 mile/24 hour events over the ensuing 14 years. Peter won the 1985 British Telecom 24 hour race staged at Colchester and the following year in the Woodford 24 hour track race he bettered 20 hours for the hundred and surpassed 120 miles in the 24 hour race.

Peter's prolific ultra distance perforances earned him a GB international vest and he did well in several of the continental classic Roubaix twenty-eight hour races. He also contributed to the administrative side of race walking, holding several offices including that of RWA President, RWA Hon. Treasuer and Centurion President

Leaguers in Action To qualify for Leaguer Status an athlete must participate in a six ERWL fixtures in a calendar year.

The **EA Winter 10,000m championships** were staged at Northampton on 9th March where Abigail Cummings added to her large collection of national championship medals.

A **Tri Counties Indoor 2,000m championships** (Herts, Kent & Middlesex) at LVAC on 16th March attracted an entry of sixteen. Luke Legon 8.53.45 and Hannah Hopper 9.46.6 were the race winners whilst Leaguers Melanie Peddle 3rd/10.50.0, Grazina Manzotti 4th/10.55.2, Maureen Noel 7th/12.22.7 finished the women's race and Colin Harle 3rd/11.37.31 the men's'.

Grazia Manzotti 6th/16.24.27 and Colin Harle 8th/17.3755 were the only two Leaguers to finish in the **Tonbridge Easter T & F 3000m** at Tonbridge School on 1st April. Fifteen started the race which was won by Luc Legon.

In persistent light rain the opening fixture of the VAC's Summer Series got underway at Battersea Park on Tuesday 2nd April. The distance was 5km and the twelve strong field was led home by Melanie Peddle 28.46 and Stuart Bennett 31.12. Other Leaguers taking part were David Walsh 4th/31.53. Fiona Bishop 8th/33.48 and Dave Hoben 10th/37.47.

Melanie Peddle and Grazia Manzotti were the only Leaguers in action at the RWA National 10km championships at the Leicester New College Cycle Circuit on 20^{th} April. In a race won by IOM's Erika Kelley in 48.25, Grazia finished $4^{th}/55.43$ and Melanie $8^{th}/59.23$.

Leaguers in Action Abroad


Torun, Poland was the venue for the **Euro Master Indoor championships** between 17th/23rd March. There were two walks; 3000m indoors and 5000m on a road course. It was a successful week for lan Richards who lifted gold medals at both distances, his times being 17.52.5 and 29.37.

Congratulations to Abigail Jennings on her new 20km pb of 1.42.55 set at the famous **Podebrady International** meeting on 6th April. Also at the meeting were Callum and George Wilkinson, both using the event to ease back into competition after a lengthy absence from the racing scene because of injury. Callum clocked 84.57 and George 10km in 50.39 at 10km indicating that they are on the way back.

David Delaney RIP It is sad to report the passing of David Delaney on 23rd March. He was a member of London Vidarians and Surrey Walking Club and qualified as a Leaguer in the Surrey team that finished fourth in the 2013 ERWL series.

I first met David in 1960 at the AAA Junior championships at Hurlingham where he finished fifth in 7.44. It was a brief meeting because I was a northerner in those days and had to dash away to catch my train home. He was unfortunate in some ways to be around when the standard of the juniors at that time was extremely high with the likes of Peter Marlow, Shaun Lightman and John Paddick, who all went on to become Olympians.

Our trails didn't cross much over the years, but in his late 60's early 70's he became an Enfield regular between 2010 and 2013 completing at least two EO7's, a Moulton 5 and the "Friendship Walk" that celebrated the Olympic Games held in London. I found him a quiet unassuming man and very supportive when he found out that I had been diagnosed with Atrial Fibrillation, a condition he also had. Most of David's performances at the time, with the exception of the 19+ miles Guernsey Church's Walk, were up to 10km and averaging 7 min kms (11 min miles), which aptly demonstrated the reason why I should not to be too downbeat about my situation.
